

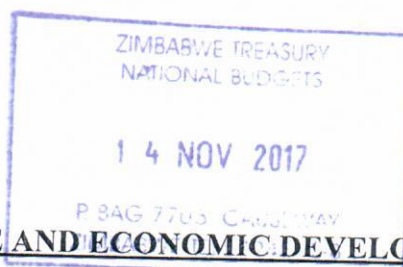
Reference is made to the minute dated 31 October 2017 requesting for co-financing commitment under the Green Climate Fund.
